## POWER ENGINEER, OPERATOR & SAFETY AWARENESS APPLICATION FOR EXAMINATION

### Examination Policies:

Ensure you have reviewed and understand the following policies and information before submitting your application.

1. Incomplete application(s) will be returned to applicant.
2. Applications for examinations must be received by Technical Safety BC by the cut-off dates noted on the examination schedule.
3. Applicants requesting the following examinations: 4A1, 4B1, 5<sup>th</sup> Class, Refrigeration Operator, Ice Facility Operator, Safety Awareness (Boiler/Refrigeration), must submit a proof of mandatory course completion with this Power Engineer, Operator & Safety Awareness Application for Examination Form.
4. There is no charge for the first re-schedule of an examination but charges will apply for the Second and subsequent re-schedule request. Re-schedule requests must be received by Technical Safety BC **12 business days** prior to the examination date. To reschedule please contact Technical Safety BC at 1 866 566 7233.
5. If an examination candidate fails to pass an examination on their **first** attempt, the candidate may not take the examination again until 30 days after the previous examination.
6. If an examination candidate fails to pass an examination on their **second** attempt, the candidate may not take the examination again until 60 days after the previous examination.
7. If an examination candidate fails to pass an examination on their **third** or subsequent attempts, the candidate may not take that particular examination again for a period of Six months.
8. Examination questions will be presented on computers unless more examinees register than computers are available, in which case any additional examinees will be issued a paper version of the exam questions.
